Educational Outreach & Art In Music Contest!

The Warren Philharmonic is committed to playing a vital role in Education and Community Outreach. Schools have been slow to recover from Covid and lack of busing for the students. Consequently, our free concerts have not resumed yet. It is our hope that we can provide such a concert to area students in the Spring of 2024. At the concert the students explore stories behind the music and get to hear each instrument alone as players give solo demonstrations.

The Orchestra normally sponsors a school-wide "Art in Music" Contest. School children are invited to create art about the orchestra's instruments and its music. Over the last 11 years, hundreds of imaginative and colorful drawings have been created and exhibited at area galleries and community centers. We are hoping to continue our Art Contest event for our 2023-24 season.
