

The Warren Philharmonic is committed to playing a vital role in Education and Community Outreach. Each year the WPO performs Free School Concerts for the area's school children. At the concert the students explore stories behind the music and get to hear each instrument alone as players give solo demonstrations. This year's School Concert is planned for October 21, 2022.
